- Statement of Purpose A purpose statement stating your goals and rationale for applying to the MS-DCA program with a brief description of your career and research expectations with regard to work and further education.
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae This document should address educational background, previous work experience, publications, performances, exhibitions, previous research experience, and community involvement.
- Letters of Recommendation These <u>must be on letterhead</u> and in PDF format and must be emailed to <u>Kara.Greene@unt.edu</u>. Please submit at least two letters from individuals who are familiar with your academic and/or professional abilities. Preferably, at least one recommendation should come from the last academic institution attended. One letter may be from a current or past employer.
- Writing/Work Samples Submit a minimum of three writing samples or examples
 of your previous work. They must be your original works of authorship. Samples
 may be news stories, technical writing, scripts, photography, design samples,
 speeches, copy, to cite a few.
- Application Packet This is the resulting document from your online application.
 This piece of your portfolio will be sent directly to Ms. Greene from the Toulouse Graduate School, and she will notify you when it is received.
